Built in May of 1971, Schwinn used the grey color only 1 year, making the “Grey Ghost” the most rare of the 6 “Krate” stingray bicycles.

This bicycle was stripped to bare metal, repainted with original Schwinn paint and reassembled. All new decals were applied. A new reproduction seat was installed. “Wow, this bicycle rides like new!”
